River Elwy

Work started late April, on a 155k complete refurbishment project of a pipe bridge over River Elwy.

This 10 week contract involves the full scaffold to be shrink wrapped encapsulated. The bridge is quill prepared, using Copon 152 and RFP top coat, with the installation of new support brackets.

This is the first pipe bridge for Welsh Water, which will hopefully lead to a breakthrough for further work in South Wales.



Wales & Portsmouth Increase work



Spring has seen a large increase in our work load in North Wales for United Utilities and also on the south coast for Portsmouth Water. With a number of schemes under way and a healthy order book for more work in each area.

The schemes are typically internal and external reservoir refurbishments using Premier Coatings Premseal 100 as the standard external roof membrane and Sika Combiflex and Sikatop 107 used as standard internally

The 1.5 Million Pound refurbishment programmes for this year with these two clients include work at Coed talog, Love-dean, Cwellyn Contact Tank, Bryn Edwin, West Meaon and Glascoed. All projects have been completed on time and within budget.
